

Terms & Conditions

1. These Terms and Conditions apply to the "*Forum Nokia Mobile Innovation Competition 2008 for University Students*" ("the Competition") which will be held from 11th February to 18th April 2008. ("Period of Competition").
2. The main organizer of this Competition is Nokia Corporation of Keilalahdentie 2-4, 02150 Espoo, Finland.
3. Before sending your submission, you must first read and accept the terms and conditions of the Competition, and agree to accept the final decision of the jury.
4. This Competition is open to students from by Aalborg University. You must be at least 18 years of age to participate. If you are under the statutory age limit in your country, you must have the permission of a parent or guardian.
5. The information related to the Competition is available at web sites created and communicated by the participating university.
6. Teams of 2-3 students can participate the Competition. Each team can submit only one entry to the Competition. No purchase or admission fee is necessary to participate.
7. The Competition closes on 18th April 2008 and eligible submissions must be received no later than end of business day on 18th April 2008. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, ineligible or misdirected submissions.
8. To enter the Competition you need to provide your full name, email address, and country of residence. The personal data you submit via the entry form will be assembled into a database that is used for evaluating the applications and managing the contest, as well as for purposes of contacting You in case of need. This data will not be used for any purposes other than for the purposes of this contest and as otherwise stated below. However, we reserve the right to display your name when showing content you have submitted to the contest, unless you separately tell us otherwise.
9. The winners will be determined by a jury appointed by Nokia in its sole discretion and such decision shall be final. No further correspondence shall be entertained. Three (3) best applications will be awarded, each team with 5.000€ + trip to S60 Summit in Barcelona Spain, May 28-29, 2008. The prizes may not be changed for cash or for value. Nokia reserves the right to substitute a suitable prize of similar value in the event any prize originally specified is not available for whatever reason. The winners shall take care of their travel insurance at their own cost.
10. The winner(s) will be contacted directly by email or telephone within thirty (30) days of being identified. If despite reasonable efforts Nokia is unable to contact a relevant winner within that period, Nokia reserves the right to choose a substitute winner.
11. Prizes will be issued to the winner(s) within forty five (45) days of contact being made by Nokia in accordance with section 11, subject to the requirement that all relevant information necessary for Nokia to issue the prize has been provided. Nokia shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) in the delivery of the prizes to the winners.
12. The prize offered will be accepted in the knowledge that the winner may become liable to local tax contributions and any Prize awarded may have to be declared on an annual tax return as required. Any tax liability will be the responsibility of the winner.
13. Entries must be the participant's own original work and may not have been previously published. The contestants also control that the submission does not misrepresent an association or connection to some person, brand or thing that it does not actually have, and is not defamatory, libelous, vulgar, obscene, derogatory, pornographic, objectionable with respect to race, religion, creed, national origin, gender or sexual preference, or is otherwise inappropriate or unfit for publication. The participant agrees to use reasonable efforts to scan and remove any viruses before submitting any material for the Competition.
14. The participant acknowledges that the submission is not submitted in confidence.
15. Submissions that are offensive or improper in nature, or are deemed harmful will be subject to disqualification.
16. The participants agree that the organizer may use, display and publish their names, for advertising and promotional purposes associated with the Competition, without additional consideration, world wide, in any media, until 31st December, 2010.
17. By submitting your information for the Competition, you hereby agree and consent to Nokia retaining and using all the data/information submitted by you for its sales, marketing and promotional efforts and to the furnishing of such data/information to Nokia related entities and their agents for such purposes. You are required to provide all requested information accurately. If you do not provide the information, you cannot participate in the Competition.

Nokia may also use your information to contact you in the future for marketing and promotional purposes. Your personal information may be disclosed to relevant authority and winners' names published as required under the relevant legislation. A request to access, update or correct any information should be directed to Nokia at the address set out above.

18. The organizer accepts no liability for lost, damaged, misdirected or delayed entries or any technical difficulties affecting the end result of the Competition or the entry to the Competition. By participating the participant, and the winners, by acceptance of their prizes, agree to release and hold harmless organizer, its affiliates, subsidiaries, and their officers, employees, agents and representatives from any and all liability, claims or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, damages or losses, which may be sustained directly or indirectly in connection with participation in this competition or with the receipt, ownership or use of the prize or while preparing for, participating in, ad/or traveling to any prize-related activity. The organizer expressly disclaims any responsibility or liability for injury or loss to any person or property relating to the delivery and/or subsequent use of the prize awarded.

By participating in the Competition, participants agree that all mobile applications submitted for the Competition shall be available to Nokia for demonstration and marketing purposes free of any royalty or licensing fees till 31st December 2010. For the avoidance of any doubt, Nokia shall not claim for the IPR ownership of the applications.
